

# DUO

## Reversible Hat

### Materials:

Yarn A: 200,225,250yards (s,m,l) striping sock yarn.

Yarn B: 200 yards solid color sock yarn.

4 or 5 US size 2/3mm dpns.

16" or 24" US size 2/3mm circular needle.

Tapestry Needle/Stitch Markers

### Gauge:

26 stitches and 40 rows for 4 inch/10cm square.

### Glossary:

CO=cast on

m1=make 1 (backwards loop or bar increase)

k2tog=knit 2 together

### Notes:

Hat sizes should fit 21"-22"/53.5-56cm head for small, 23"/58.5cm head for medium, and 24"/ 61cm head for large sizes. Hat is knit from top down, then decreased and pushed inside of itself to create a reversible hat. Hat is started on dpns and changed to circular when necessary and back to dpns when decreasing. Optional stitch markers can be placed before increases and decreases if wanted. *It is best to weave in any loose ends on wrong side before the decreases as the inside cannot be accessed once decreases are complete.*

### Instructions:

#### *For all sizes:*

With Yarn A CO 10 stitches. Divide evenly on 3 or 4 dpns. Join and being careful not to twist stitches and mark beginning of round with marker.

Rnd 1: knit

Rnd 2: (k1, m1) to end of round. (20 stitches)

Rnd 3: knit

Rnd 4: (k2,m1) to end of round. (30 stitches)

Rnd 5: knit

Rnd 6: (k3,m1) to end of round. (40 stitches)

Rnd 7: knit

Rnd 8: (k4,m1) to end of round. (50 stitches)

Rnd 9: knit

Rnd 10: knit

Rnd 11: (k5,m1) to end of round. (60 stitches)

Rnd 12: knit

Rnd 13: knit

Rnd 14: (k6,m1) to end of round. (70 stitches)

Rnd 15: knit

Rnd 16: knit

Rnd 17: (k7,m1) to end of round. (80 stitches)

Rnd 18: knit

Rnd 19: knit

Rnd 20: (k8,m1) to end of round. (90 stitches)

Rnd 21: knit

Rnd 22: knit

Rnd 23: (k9,m1) to end of round. (100 stitches)

Rnd 24: knit

Rnd 25: knit

Rnd 26: knit

Rnd 27: (k10,m1) to end of round. (110 stitches)

Rnd 28: knit

Rnd 29: knit

Rnd 30: knit

Rnd 31: (k11,m1) to end of round. (120 stitches)

Rnd 32: knit

Rnd 33: knit

Rnd 34: knit

#### *For small sizes only:*

Rnd 35: (k24,m1) to end of round. (125 stitches)

End of increases for small size.

#### *For Medium sizes only:*

Rnd 35: (k12,m1) to end of round. (130 stitches)

Rnd 36: knit

Rnd 37: knit

Rnd 38: knit

Rnd 39: (k26,m1) to end of round. (135 stitches)

End of increases for medium sizes.

#### *For Large sizes only:*

Rnd 35: (k12,m1) to end of round. (130 stitches)

Rnd 36: knit

Rnd 37: knit

Rnd 38: knit

Rnd 39: (k13,m1) to end of round. (140 stitches)

Rnd 40: knit

Rnd 41: knit

Rnd 42: knit

Rnd 43: (k28,m1) to end of round. (145 stitches)

End of increases for large sizes.

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### *For all sizes*

Continue knitting even until hat measures (9"/23cm, 9 1/2"/24cm, 10"/25.5cm) from beginning. Cut color A.

Join B and continue knitting for 3.5"/9cm

Begin decreasing as follows:

### *For Large sizes only:*

Decrease Rnd: (k27,k2tog) to end of round. (140 stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd: (k12,k2tog) to end of round. (130 stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd: (k11,k2tog) to end of round. (120 stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

### *For Medium sizes only:*

Decrease Rnd: (k25,k2tog) to end of round. (130 stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd: (k11,k2tog) to end of round. (120 stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

### *For Small sizes only:*

Decrease Rnd: (k23,k2tog) to end of round. (120 stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

### *For all sizes ( 120 stitches):*

Decrease Rnd 1: (k10,k2tog) to end of round. (110 stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd 2: (k9,k2tog) to end of round. (100stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd 3: (k8,k2tog) to end of round. (90stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd 4: (k7,k2tog) to end of round. (80stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd 5: (k6,k2tog) to end of round. (70stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd 6: (k5,k2tog) to end of round. (60stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd 7: (k4,k2tog) to end of round. (50stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd 8: (k3,k2tog) to end of round. (40stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd 9: (k2,k2tog) to end of round. (30stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd 7: (k1,k2tog) to end of round. (20stitches)

Next Rnd: knit

Decrease Rnd 8: k2tog around. (10 stitches)

Cut yarn and thread tail through tapestry needle. Run tail through remaining 10 stitches and fasten off. Do not cut yarn. Push hat side with yarn B inside of other side with yarn A and using tapestry needle with remaining tail attach side B to A at center top of hat and secure. Weave in loose end and cut yarn.

Once finished there should be an inch of yarn A showing at the bottom of hat on yarn B side.

Block hat if necessary.
